Then it's off to the cooking center where you can enjoy some tea and refreshments before your cooking class.

Then the cooking demonstration and master class will begin. You will cook a selection of local dishes as well as learn how to recognize basic ingredients under the chef's guidance. When the dishes are ready enjoy some of them for lunch along with wine and soft drinks.

On the way back to the pier and the ship relax as you see some highlights of this lively city, including a cyclo ride to the 19th century Notre Dame Cathedral, built with material imported from France, and the attractive colonial-style Post Office, two of the city's most famous landmarks.
